

Procedure for endorsement of credits for participation in general competence skills development activities

Doctoral committee of Physics N 002 endorses credits for participation in these general competence skills development activities and trainings:

- for participation in general competence skills development activities and trainings, summer/winter schools – will be endorsed the amount of credits specified in the certificate(s) (up to 5 ECTS credits);
- for participation in activities that strengthen general abilities: for the dissemination of science to the general public – up to 1 ECTS credit, for the organization of conferences – up to 1 ECTS credit;
- for pedagogical activities: a) for guiding students' written works – 1 ECTS credit, b) for exercises, laboratory work, practice, seminars, lectures – 1 ECTS credit/semester;
- for research internship or partial studies abroad: 0.5 ECTS credit/month.
- for other general competence skills development activities, if approved by the committee.

Doctoral committee of Chemistry N 003 endorses credits for participation in the following activities and trainings that strengthen general abilities:

- Participation in general ability strengthening activities and trainings organized by VU or other Lithuanian or foreign institutions (the number of ECTS credits is indicated in the certificate(s));
- General abilities subject for doctoral students "Academic writing" (3 ECTS credits);
- Unpaid pedagogical practice (1 ECTS credit is granted for 25-30 academic hours);
- For participation in the international doctoral school-conference "Advanced materials and technologies" (1 ECTS credit);
- Organization of conferences (1 ECTS credit, the doctoral student must be included in the organizing committee);
- Science popularization activities: science popularization article in a science popularization magazine, participation in one TV or radio show, podcast (0.5 ECTS credits);
- Learning foreign languages. For doctoral students from abroad, the learning of the Lithuanian language is also credited (the number of ECTS credits is indicated in the certificate(s));
- for other general competence skills development activities, if approved by the committee.

Doctoral committee of Material Engineering T 008 endorses credits for participation in these general competence skills development activities and trainings:

- for participation in general competence skills development activities and trainings, summer/winter schools – will be endorsed the amount of credits specified in the certificate(s) (up to 5 ECTS credits);
- for participation in activities that strengthen general abilities: for the dissemination of science to the general public and for the organization of conferences – up to 1 ECTS credit;
- for pedagogical activities: exercises, laboratory work, practice, seminars, lectures - up to 2 ECTS credits (1 ECTS credit / 25 academic hours);
- for other general competence skills development activities, if approved by the committee.
